- 1) You can book for as little as 2 players through to groups of 100 people.
- 2) WASP Paintball is the longest running paintball company in WA with over 20 years of experience. We are owned and operated by local paintball players. Paintball is our passion.
- 3) WE run a morning and afternoon session - 3 hours and you can opt out anytime you like (you are not locked into one time slot for an all day session).
- 4) We also run children with children, adults with adults (where possible or unless requested we don't run children with adults). Safety and fun is what we care about!
- 5) We run groups of approx 20 people unless requested otherwise. So if you have 20 or more people in your group, the field is yours!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How long are the paintball sessions?

All of the WASP fields offer a morning (8.45 for 9am start) or afternoon (12.15pm for a 12.30pm start) 3 hour paintball session. You can play the full 3 hours or opt out anytime you like. WASP is open for bookings 7-days a week - including Saturday and Sundays (but you must pre-book). Clackline paintball sessions can be run all day, depending on how long you want to play.

How Are the Paintball games run?

You are rotated around the different playing paintball fields during your session. Each paintball field has a different game and objective to it. When you are hit, you are side lined until the next paintball game begins. The paintball games are turned around quite quickly, so you are never on the sideline for long. 2 refs are placed for each group of 20 players during your paintball session.

Safety first!

All packages include the hire of paintball markers, safety goggles, protective clothing and paints. Safety is our number one priority for all players at WASP. Prior to each and every game professional referees thoroughly explain the rules of the game and all safety protocols are strictly enforced. Following are a selection of our most frequently asked questions.

Does it hurt?

Not if you are wearing our long overalls and a chest protector (recommended for children and woman). Plus for the boys we suggest you bring your own cricket box or buy one from us on the day. If shot at close range on bare skin then you may feel the paintball and at worst it might leave a small welt.

Are deposits required and how do I pay them?

A \$20 per person deposit is required to secure your booking and is then deducted from your package price on the day. To ensure there is no confusion regarding your group payment, we request all deposits are collected by the organiser or nominated person and then paid to us, rather than individual players sending deposits. For example you have 5 players x \$20 = \$100 deposit.

How do I pay my group deposit?

VISA/MASTER CARD

This can be done over the phone and a receipt number can be issued, please request when booking. Call 0418 912 795. Receipts/invoices can be issued for companies that wish to claim back their team day please request when booking.

No shows/Cancellations

Please note - If a member or group fails to attend on your day of play, deposits will not be returned and you will forfeit them, unless 24-hours notice has been given by each individual player to WASP Paintball and then we will either exchange the deposit amount for extra paint on the day of play or give you a WASP gift voucher to the deposit amount owed.

What should I wear?

Dress for the weather but keep in mind you are given a pair of overalls that goes over your clothing, so it can get hot. Sensible shoes are a must (you will be playing in the woods therefore sneakers are recommended). Also wear a cap and bring a cricket box along for the boys or we do sell them for \$5.

Can I bring my own equipment?

Any paintball approved marker or goggles may be used as long as they meet our safety standards. All markers must be licensed and shoot less than 300 feet per second and will be tested before being allowed on the fields.

How old do I have to be to play?

Players must be 12 years of age or over to play. Or 8 years and over for laser. Children between the ages of 12 to 16 years must be accompanied by at least one guardian per group. All children from 12 to 17 years of age must submit a Junior Consent form which needs to be signed by their parents to play. Download a WASP Junior Consent Form.

Who plays paintball?

Everyone! Both men and women enjoy the sport of paintball. Paintball is especially popular with corporate groups, sports clubs, birthday parties and bucks and hens!

What happens when there is bad weather?

Paintball games are played rain, hail or shine. Very rarely are games cancelled due to bad weather (paintball is just as fun in the rain as it is on a sunny day).

Are the games supervised?

All games played at WASP are supervised by trained paintball referees. Safety is strictly enforced and is our number one priority!

Operating days

WASP is open 7-days-a-week by appointment. Including all public holidays except Christmas Day and New Years day.
